Message from the Presbyter

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lenten season is the biggest opportunity of renewal in our life. We should not get perturbed by the strict regulations of Lenten season. Normally, we consider this season as a dry season when no marriages and parties are encouraged. To those, who are used to eating meat, a strict vegetarian diet would be a horrible idea. Restricting our earthly habits is a way of controlling our earthly desires. For spiritual gain we need to restrict our earthly desires. But often we tend to restrict only our food habits, which is much easier or less harmful as far as desires are concerned.

There are other harmful and dangerous human desires, which we ignore during Lenten season: Desire towards worldly possession, opposite sex, alcohol, cigarettes and other harmful drugs, which can destroy our body and our inner relationship with Christ. Our inner emotions such as anger, greed, jealousy, haughtiness, disrespectful manners, etc. can create havoc in our spiritual life with God and others. So Lent is not only for regulating our culinary habits but our entire aspect of life for the glory of God.

Admittedly, sin stands opposite to spiritual dimensions in our lives. We err and fall into sin because we are weak in our spiritual life. The only way to strengthen our spiritual dimension is by a constant reading and meditation of the word of God and by spending time with God in prayer. These are the basic steps of spirituality but essential all throughout our life.

Lent is also a time to do good works. Apostle Paul writes in Ephesians: "we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do" (Eph 2:10). Good works are part of God's design for us. But we tend to do either bad works or no works, which we understand as part of our fallen nature. It is this nature, which we need to overcome. Jesus Christ has come to help us in this process of doing good works by changing our fallen nature. That is why Jesus said: "You cannot bear fruit unless you abide in me" (John 15:4). Fruits are the good works that is seen in us and Jesus is sufficient or helpful enough to produce good works in us.

Good works are those that are seen within our own nature and in our relationship with others. Change in our nature is basically the work of God and we are only cooperating with God to see it actualized. Doing good to others outwardly is as important as changing our inner behavior. But it should come as part of our inner change. Otherwise all the worldly elements of greed, self-importance, and pride can control even our good works. Therefore we must guard ourselves against all evil intentions in all the things that we do.

Determination to change our bad behavior, abiding in Christ through word of God and prayer **and** doing good works must go hand in hand. We cannot draw a definite pattern in the process of spiritual

progress. But God is able to effect such changes in our life if we abide in Christ. Therefore let us make use of this Lenten season as an opportunity to fulfill our spiritual desires and tasks. Remember Jesus' words: "You cannot do anything unless you abide in me."

I am blessed. Whom Shall I fear?

Based on Psalm 27 and the Book of Genesis Rendition by P K Abraham

God has created you and me and blessed us abundantly. We are children of God(1 John 3:1). The LORD protects and preserves us— we are counted among the blessed in the land— he does not give us over to the desire of the foes. (Psalm 41:2). He guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones.(Proverbs 27:18)

The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom **shall** I **fear**? The LORD is the stronghold of my life— of whom **shall** I **be afraid**? When the wicked advance against me to devour me, it is my enemies and my foes who will stumble and fall. Though an army besiege me, my heart will **not fear**; though war break out against me, even then I will be confident.

Listen to His assurance. "I myself will search for my sheep and look after them. As a shepherd looks after his scattered flock when he is with them, so will I look after my sheep. I will rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on a day of clouds and

darkness" (Ezekiel 34:11 & 12). I will look after you; ---. Look, the whole country lies before you; go wherever you please. (Jeremiah 40.4)

What has he done for you? 'I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'(Matthew 25:36). His grace is much more than that of the good Samaritan who took care of the robbed and waylaid by taking him to an inn after nursing him. The Samaritan left the waylaid in the care of the inn-keeper with some money and further promise to pay for all expenses.

We are blessed right from the sixth day of creation. God created them as man and female in his own image. He **blessed** them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground." **Genesis 1:28** .God blessed Abram, Issac, Rebekha, Jacob, all the descendents and all households. Finally Lord's promise to Abraham stands out as the reward. After this, the word of the LORD came to Abraham in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great **reward**."
