# Message from the Presbyter

Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

"Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ".

"Woe to you, Korazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes".

Mathew 11:21

'Woe' the Greek word means sorrowful pity. This is not the accent of one who is in a bad temper or anger. It is the accent of sorrow, the accent of one who offered men the most precious thing in the world and saw it disregarded. Jesus' condemnation of sin is holy anger, but the anger comes, not from outraged pride but from a broken heart.

What was the charge against the cities of Galilee? Korazin was probably a town, an hour's journey north of Capernaum; Bethsaida was a fishing village on the west bank of Jordan, just as the river entered the northern end of the lake. Here we can see the sin of the people who forgot the responsibilities of privilege. It was the sin of indifference and a sin to do nothing.

#### Irresponsibility:

The greater our privileges have been, the greater is our condemnation, if we fail to shoulder the responsibilities and accept the obligations, which these privileges bring with them. Jesus gave much importance to these cities and expected responsible attitude from these cities. Likewise, when we have been elected or selected in different positions and power, God is expecting us to function more for him. There is a difference in condemning a child and an adult, between a savage and a civilized man. Today as Christians, we are neglecting to shoulder the responsibilities and not allowing anybody to step forward. A hindrance to Christian work is a sin. (Mathew 23:13)

#### **Indifference:**

In Mathew 23: 13 the word Jesus uttered was *hypocrite*. It is a Greek word for an actor. It then came to mean an actor in the worst sense of the term, a pretender, one who act a part, one who wears a mask to cover his true feelings, one who puts on an external show while inwardly his thoughts and feelings are very different. These cities did not attack Jesus Christ; they did not drive him from their gates; they did not seek to crucify him; they simply disregarded him. Neglect can kill as much as persecution can. Are we in this scenario showing indifference to promote talents of our children, youth and spiritual growth of the church as a whole? Often we are forgetting to appreciate others in their good work. Indifferent attitude spoils the smooth relationship and growth of our church.

#### Inaction:

There are sins of action, sins of deed; but there is also a sin of inaction, and of absence of deeds. The sin of Korazin, of Bethsaida, and of Capernaum was the sin of doing nothing. Many a man's defense is 'But I never did anything". That defense may be in fact his condemnation. Many times, we are regular in church worships, giving offerings, participating in all church activities but we are forgetting the claims of mercy, forgetting fidelity, irritable and bad-tempered and mean with our money. Without taking any kind of risk in doing things especially in the spiritual realm, in helping others, without showing concerns to the social issues and prohibiting social evils etc., is the trend of today's world. Are we like the Laodicea Church mentioning in Rev.3:14, a state of Lukewarm-neither hot nor cold?

In Mathew 23:13-36, projects seven "Woes" of Jesus Christ against the Scribes and the Pharisees for being an obstacle in the door to the Kingdom of Heaven. Are we an obstacle to the Church? Let us use the word of hope always......why not, it is possible with Christ.

This month we are celebrating the Independence Day of our great nation India. Let us remember all the freedom fighters and their sacrifice. Also, pray for our nation, all believing community and thank God almighty for the freedom of worship.
