Message from the Presbyter

Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

"Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ".

"Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." Mark.10:14

This month we are observing World Sunday School Sunday, Unity Sunday, and CNI formation Day. The sacrifice, tiresome work and prayer of some of our Christian leaders paved the way for these organizations and Churches.Let us see the formation and importance of Sunday school in different perspective.

I.Historical Background:-The Sunday school movement began in England in the 1780s. The English journalist Robert Raikes (1725-1811) was the key promoter of the movement. He got the inspiration when he saw some of the street children doing immoral and mischievous activities in one Sunday morning. When Raikes, intervened into their quarrel, they ridiculedhim and threw upon him dirty water. He started to teach them cleanliness, moral values, reading, writing and also Bible stories. Slowly the school started growing. It was widespread in England in 1795. It soon spread to America as well. Denominations and non-denominational organizations caught the vision and energetically began to create Sunday schools. Within decades, the movement had become extremely popular. The movement started with a school, for boys in the slums who were working in the factories for long hours as slaves. The best available time was Sunday as the boys were often working in the factories the other six days. The best available teachers were lay people. The textbook was the Bible, and the originally intended curriculum started with learning to read and then progressed to the catechism. In 1803 London Sunday school union started. Within few years, Sunday schools were started in Ireland and Scotland. In 1880, world Sunday school conference was conducted in London. For the Christian education, a World Council was formed in 1947. It was decided by the World Sunday School Association to observe November 1st Sunday in every year as World Sunday School day.

Initially at Allahabad, Sunday school ministry was started and then moved to Kunoor, Neelgiri in India from 1876 onwards. Under the leadership of Arch Deacon of Anglican Church, Rev. Oommen Mammen, Sunday school was started in Kerala at Mallapally in 1880. Today in Kerala itself, more than 3 lakh children are studying Sunday school.

II. Biblical Perspective:-The Bible passage in Mark 10:14 focus the characteristics of a child. They are the following:

Humility: The children do not have selfishness of pride, prestige, and publicity. So they do not think about the power and politics in their mind. Friendship with their fellows, love and care are they needed the most.

Obedience: The child often disobeys and grumbles at his parent's bidding. However, his instinct is to obey. He knows very well that he should obey and is not happy when he has been disobedient. In his heart of hearts, his parents' word is law.

Trust: It includes child's acceptance and authority. They think their father and mother know everything, and that his/her father and mother is always right. Another thing in trust is the confidence in other people. The child does not expect any person to be bad. He will make friendship with a perfect stranger. The child has not yet learned to suspect the world. He/she still believes the best about others.

Forgiveness:He has not yet learned to bear grudges and nourish bitterness. The child completely forgets and forgives.

The reason behind Jesus' narration about the children is that one should have the qualities of a child in order to enter the Kingdom of God. This needs humility, Obedience, Trust and forgiveness. To hinder the persons having such qualities are neglecting the Kingdom of God. To be an obstacle to these qualities to our life is also away from the Kingdom of God. This passage clearly focuses on encouraging children to know our Lord Jesus Christ, the Love and compassion and also to nurture good Christian values, to inculcate good standards of life, to make them good leaders in the Church and Society. Are we a hindrance to the Kingdom of God by not sending our children to Sunday school? Are we able to help them to live according to the Will of our Lord? Are we providing Christian atmosphere to our Children?
