Message from the Presbyter

Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

“Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ”.

“Go to the ant you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise.” Proverbs 6:6

A great man called Tamerlane conducted researches on ants. He came across some interesting facts about ants. Like humans, they too have a place in the world. Even the Bible tells us to learn from them. When ants have some work to do, they would not rest until it is finished. Their small legs are very active. They never get tired. They find pleasure in work. Ants do not need a leader or a supervisor. In the military there is a commander, a country has a ruler and in a house, there are elders to guide us. But the collective work of ants is admirable. We can learn mainly four things from ants. They are the following:-

1. Self-motivation:

No one carries a whip behind the ant to ensure that the work is being done. No ant mothers nag their babies to get out of bed. These creatures are self-motivated, and need no captain to give orders to his soldiers or to look after for their sincerity. Why? Their work is for their own good! As Christians, maturity means no longer we need someone to stand behind us and prompting us to come to the church, read the Bible, sing a song, to coordinate, to attend the church committee, prayer meetings and to help each other.

2. Look ahead:

In the summer and in the harvest, food is plentiful. Yet the ant refuses to take her ease—instead of working harder, storing up against the coming time of scarcity. “The ants are people not strong, yet they prepare their food in the summer” (Prov 30:25). One of our great failures is only looking at the few feet in front of our nose—neither

preparing for the future nor considering the consequences of our action—and inaction.

3. Help each other:

Another lesson we learn from ants is that we should help each other. To lift eggs from one place to another, three or four ants together will help each other. In some parts of our country, people carry their loads by tying them to the two ends of a pole. In this way, they can carry two pots easily instead of one. In the same way by helping each other we can help others to carry their loads. The Bible says “carry each other’s burdens”.

4. Hard work:

Laziness will lead to poverty, with precious few exceptions. But the hard work of ants sustains them. Christians need a willingness to work hard to earn their wages, and to work even harder to please their Lord. There is tremendous value in this! Many of us might prefer just to stay in bed, but working hard will bless our lives physically and spiritually.

So let us take up all our projects, responsibilities, God given talents for the betterment of our Church. Let us learn to self motivate, look ahead, help each other and do hard work like ants with a mind of unity. Collective work and spiritual maturity help us to do amazing things in the years to come.
