Message from the Presbyter

Dear Friends in Christ,

Lent season is coming near. March 5 is Ash Wednesday and we are beginning our lenten season from that day onwards till Easter except on intervening Sundays. Lenten season is a period for spiritual rejuvenation and focusing our life with God.

Lenten season culminates in Easter celebration. It points to a greater truth that fasting or observing lent is not a good in itself but it is deemed a good with respect to knowing God through Jesus' passion and resurrection. Physical realm assumes significance only in relation with the spiritual entity. If we try to focus on physical discipline without spiritual understanding, that will lead us into confusion and chaos.

Lent is not a mere means of regulating our eating habits. Culinary discipline is one of the areas where we try to balance and moderate. One should eat to live and not the other way around. Hence one should not always splurge on our blessings which God has bestowed on us, but rather have a giving heart, the same giving heart Jesus has for you and me. If lent means only an abstinence from eating meat without any further end, it does not amount to a virtue.

There are many other things that we concentrate on in the lenten season. According to our church tradition, after Ash Wednesday, we meet together on every following Wednesdays till Passion Week for worship and prayer. Here it will be on Fridays for our convenience. This is to teach us the importance of taking more time with God for our spiritual renewal. Therefore during lenten season we devote more time to prayer and fellowship as we enter into the most important period of our church calendar in which we remember God's act of securing salvation for humankind through Jesus' death and resurrection. The practice of taking more time with God that we develop during lenten season must continue beyond the lenten period in our personal life to yield good result and in the next year it must produce an increased result.

Prayer life and meditation of the word of God will change our attitude from within. God will help us through prayer life and the teachings of the word of God to be created into a new being. Jesus has come into the world to make us into a new creation and present us before God holy and blameless (Eph 1: 4). This new creation is what we need to experience during the lenten season.

Once we experience the new creation, there are good works to follow. The first struggle would be to overcome the power of sin in our life. As long as we are in this world we will be under the influence of sin, but we can achieve victory through Jesus to defeat sin in our life. We must draw closer to God to derive strength from Him to overcome sin. This must happen during our lenten season through our prayer and meditation of the Word.

Bible teaches us to do many virtuous acts. We must try to adopt these qualities one by one in our life. This is how we grow spiritually. We adopt these qualities not to boast or to be praised by others or to obtain salvation. Salvation is a free gift from God through Jesus and we are saved by his sacrificial death and resurrection. It is Jesus' work that secures salvation to us and not ours'. Good work is the natural outcome of our faith in Jesus Christ. Bible teaches us that we are not saved "by" good works, but we are saved "for" good works (Eph 2: 8-10)

May God help us during this lenten season to comprehend the breadth and length and height and depth of the love of God for us (Eph 3: 18). Amen

Church Picnic

After reaching the destination, it was the time for dinner. People got hold of their shelter quickly and came back for dinner. Cabins were allotted for ladies and tents for gents.

There was campfire after dinner, around which, all the participants gathered together and performed different programs. Sunday school children sang songs and youth organized games. There was evening and there was morning the first day.

The second day started with worship service at 9:30am. Breakfast was served at 8:30am and after the worship service people got ready for water activity. Sunday School Exams

Sunday school exams were conducted jointly for the first time on Feb 9, Sunday. Both Sanpada and Panvel worshipping centre Sunday school teachers participated in the question paper preparation and paper evaluation. Sunday school coordinator, Mrs. Shelly Abraham took enough care to conduct these exams neatly.

There was teachers meeting arranged on the following Sunday after the exams and following points were discussed for the betterment of Sunday school.

1. Sunday school timing need to be stabilized for one hour on all occasions even at the time of breakfast and afternoon worship service arrangements. It was decided to conduct Sunday school on all Sundays as far as possible and the time was scheduled from 8.45am-9.45am.

2. It was observed that children come to Sunday school without adequate preparations- without notebooks, pencils and Bible. Therefore it was requested to remind parents of their duty to send children prepared for Sunday school.

3. It was also suggested that if children study their lessons every Sunday, it would help them to have a better understanding of the subject rather than studying at the last moment only for exam. It was noticed that some children were searching for notes at the last moment, which is unacceptable. Parents need to ensure that children write their Sunday school notes every Sunday and discuss with teachers if proper notes were not found.
