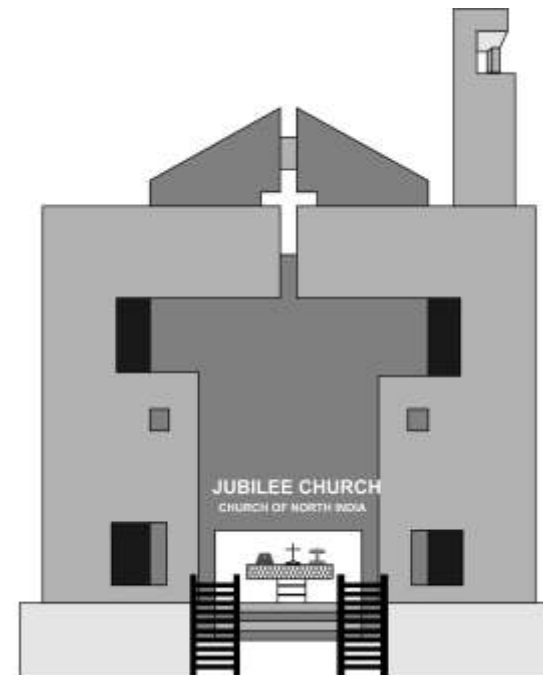

*From the Presbyter's desk...*

*Dear Friends in Christ,*

*Someone told me few months ago that he is being caught up in a thought about what is seen and unseen. We can see only things that are surrounding us, but Bible says unseen are eternal.*

*This is quite fascinating. What motivate us to act are our surroundings, things that can be seen. These that can be seen are real but also at the same time temporal. That is why in Indian Tradition people says world is Maya, which means an illusion.*

*Then what is real. Bible says things that are not seen are eternal. That means eternal things are real. Thus Bible pictures two kinds of reality, one at the lower level where we see everything as real and another at the higher level, which we cannot see but are called to enter in and join with the beings higher than us, which is ever real.*

*Bible also says in Ecclesiastes that all is vanity. Why things appear to us as vanity because God, who, brings meaning and value to our life is not present. So without God anything and everything can appear as unreal, illusory and vanity.*

*Spiritual Revival Meetings were an example or a stage where unseen and eternal world came closer to our reality. There was a person, who claimed to be seeing visions of a different world from ours but also at the same time translates through those visions things of this world, which will appear to us as real. Then the question is what about that world that he sees. If he can translate through those visions, things of this world, which are real to us, then should it not be that that world, which he claims to be seeing, is also real? It is real to the person who sees it than those who hear it. It can become a reality to those who hear it, only by faith. That is why faith is described in the Bible as "substance of the things hoped for and the evidence of the things not seen". But here in that one person only, faith is becoming a seen and ever present reality before his own very eyes. Jesus once said: if ③*

*have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you heavenly things?" (John 3: 12)*

*It does not mean that reality was present only at that time of space. It is ever present before our eyes but we do not see it. So Jesus said: "For judgment I came into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind" (John 9: 39)*

*Now let us open our eyes of faith and see the things that we hoped for and live according to that hope in our given situation of reality and thereby enter into the ever present reality. May God bless us all.*
