Message from the Presbyter

Dear Beloved- in- Christ,

"Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ".

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. (Colo.3:1)

Human values are being diminished. Respect to fellow beings, relationship within the family life, maturity in Spirituality are lacking. Science and technology has developed the world a lot but the attitude of humans to their fellow beings and towards God is not developed as much as St. Paul has considered. He not only urges the Colossian Christians but also to us that we should not be deceived by vain philosophies, legalistic rules, and worldly practices.

New Set of Values

St. Paul here, was not criticizing the world. The earthly things, "things upon the earth" to be avoided are moral, not physical. Paul in his theological thought tries to give us a new set of life. For him **Giving** above getting, **Serving** above ruling, **Forgiving** above avenging are important. The Christian standard of values will be God's, not human's. Since believers have not only died with Christ but have also been raised with Christ (Rom.6:8-10; Col.2:12-13), they should set their hearts on things above. That is, believers' lives should be dominated by the pattern of heaven, bringing heavenly direction to their earthly duties. "Set" means to 'Seek or strive for earnestly'. Fixing their attention decisively toward things above involves centering their lives on the ascended glorified Christ, who is seated at the right hand of God. Here in this passage, two meanings are there in the word 'set' which is **striving** and **concentrating**. But today are we really 'setting' our hearts and minds to Christ.

In Mathew 7:7-12, we can see 'ask, seek and knock'. But what we are asking for? What we are seeking for? Where we are knocking for? We are running behind Churches, fellowship groups, prayer cells, Bible classes, and convention centers. But what about our attitude in sharing, caring, giving, risk taking, respecting etc? By knowing something from the bible and hymns, are

we pretending that we are higher-level people? Are we considering others inhuman or unworthy to mingle with? Are we, the only chosen one in this earth having lot of talents? In order to avoid all sorts of false assumptions and wrong insights we should raise our eyes to the lord of Love. The life in this world will be better if it is lived by a power beyond this world, the power of the resurrected, ascended, glorified Christ. That is the reason, Paul, in I Corinthians 13:1-13 states the excellent way of life, the love. In order to reach the fullness of life we have to receive his grace, which is stated in John 1:16 'From the fullness of his grace we have all received one blessing after another'.

As a believing community, shall we seek spiritual values (col.3:14), put off the sins of the old life (Col.3:5-11) and put on the virtues of the new life (Col 3:12-17). This in turn should affect the relationships with one another (Col 3:18-4:1). What are the challenges set before us? Are we avoiding the crying voices, begging hands and bowing figures before us? Shall we set out hearts and minds on things above and receive the blessing to sit with Christ in His throne (Rev. 20:4).
